The Marine Pioneer: what and why?


- The four pioneers have been set up to test approaches to delivering the 25 Year Environment Plan (2YEP) (published January 2018)
- The aim of the 25YEP is to leave the environment in a better state for the next generation than it was for our generation
- The pioneers have specifically been asked to
 - **Test new tools and methods** as part of applying a natural capital approach;
 - Demonstrate a **joined-up, integrated approach** to planning and delivery;
 - Pioneer and 'scale-up' the use of **new funding opportunities**; and
 - Grow our understanding of what works, **sharing lessons and best practice**.
- The aim of the Marine Pioneer is to do the above for the marine environment using partnership projects in North Devon and Suffolk.

The Marine Pioneer Programme so far

- Setting the vision with stakeholders in North Devon and Suffolk
- Developing demonstration projects specific to the locations and vision
- Using a project officer and steering group to develop and monitor the project work
- Liaising with and updating Defra regularly on activities
- Holding the Natural Capital Conference, Decision Support Tool workshop, 2nd Stakeholder workshop and Marine Pioneer Conference
- Using the 'How to do it' workbook and 25YEP to guide the work
- Developing an overview of the programme that reflects work in Suffolk and North Devon.....
