The project offers:

Financial contribution at Countryside Stewardship rates towards woodland and watercourse fencing, coppicing bankside trees, ground preparation (scrub clearance and treatment), rural sustainable drainage systems (e.g sediment ponds/silt traps) and natural flood management options (e.g. leaky/log dams/field bunds) to improve water quality and reduce downstream flood risk.

Funding for woodland planting under 1 ha can be applied for through the Woodland Trust and schemes over 1 ha can be guided through more appropriate Countryside Stewardship Schemes with larger recurring payments.
